## National Grid is consulting on proposals to reinforce the high-voltage electricity transmission network between Norwich, Bramford and Tilbury.

The proposed reinforcement is around 180 km and would comprise mostly overhead line (including pylons and conductors – the ‘line’ part), underground cabling through the Dedham Vale Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty (AONB) and a new substation in the Tendring district.

It will play a vital role in delivering new sources of electricity efficiently, reliably, and safely and will support the UK’s move to net zero.
